WHAT TO DO IN AN ACTIVE SHOOTER INCIDENT

The United States Department of Homeland Security defines the active shooter as “an individual actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area. In most cases, active shooters use firearms and there is no pattern or method to the selection of victims”. On average, 20 mass shootings take place in the U.S. every year. Just like fire drills and earthquake preparedness, making a plan in advance will make all the difference.

Lt. Vincente Osorio is a lieutenant with Gardena Police Department and the Emergency Preparedness Coordinator with the City of Gardena. He is also our police representative on our TRI-CITY CERT Association Board.

A refresher exercise will be further discussion on active shooter as well as triage and basic treatment following an active shooter incident. Jose Hernandez, our President will also show how to make a “soda can stove.”
