

MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION

Southwest Water System

12% Water Use Reduction Required

Effective 6/1/15

Stage 1

- Water outdoors only <u>Sunday and Wednesday</u> if your address ends with
 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8
- Water outdoors only <u>Tuesday and Saturday</u> if your address ends with 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9
- Water outdoors only between the hours of 7:00 PM and 8:00 AM
- No outdoor watering within 48 hours of rain
- Violation of the rules may result in flow restrictors being installed at customer expense
 - Previous Rules Still Apply!
 - No runoff from sprinklers allowed
 - No washing of cars without a shut off nozzle
 - No hosing down driveways and sidewalks
 - Only recirculating water fountains

Please Note: Failure to reduce water consumption by 12% may result in additional restrictions and surcharges as detailed in Stages 2, 3 and 4 of the attached.

12% Reduction in Water Usage Requested

The State Water Resources Control Board has approved new regulations targeting a 12% reduction in water use (based on 2013 figures) for Golden State Water Company customers in your service area.

The approved regulations include restrictions on water use as detailed in the attached Notice of Staged Mandatory Water Conservation and Emergency Drought Regulation documents.

Golden State Water Company understands that irrigation and HOA customers face special challenges in their efforts to achieve water reduction during periods of drought and mandatory water rationing.
